Saturday's match began as a hazy day with humidity at 89%. Wind was almost non-existent with small breezes of 0 to 3 mph. Once the match started, the conditions were ideal with no wind and a cloudy overcast keeping the temperature mild. Before the match could be completed, a downpour began which continued until after 2:30 PM.

Eleven shooters attended the AA match. Due to rain, only four shooters completed the course. Benney Davis and David Still tied to win the match with scores of 38 of 54 (70.4%) shoots. No Precharged winner was determined due to "Did Not Finish" (DNF) status.

In the DNF Class, Robert Crocker won the Precharged DNF Class with 40 of 42 (95.2%). Walt Roller won the Spring DNF Class with a score of 36 of 48 (75%)
